Zeitgeist Community Learning Center is a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit organization. We give homework assistance, tutoring (in math and reading), and mentoring. We also expose our students to the world through art, science, yoga, cultural, global and environmental awareness through workshops and field trips. Our mission is to provide a safe, enjoyable, and holistic learning environment that encourages young people to take an active and creative part in their own development as future leaders, and then to use that self-discovery to fully participate in and enhance the world around them.



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What we do

We work with small groups of children from the **3rd through the 5th grade** during the school year. During the school year, the program runs from Monday-Friday, 2:30 to 6:00 pm. Our summer program runs from July to August. During our summer program we operate Mondays-Fridays from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. Times vary when we go on full day field trips.

Please note: When space is available, new student enrollment takes place at the beginning of the fall, winter and summer semesters.



TYPICAL SCHEDULE

A typical day during the school year from Monday-Thursday:

Quiet time (5-10 minute meditation)
Homework assistance*
Skill building exercises/reading/group academic activities
Snack time (organic snacks from Trader Joe's & Whole Foods)
Educational Internet activities

*Fluency, math application and reading skills are assessed.

On Fridays:

Special projects-art, writing, movies, workshops, computer games, yoga, guest speakers

On Saturdays:

Math Workshop (2-3 Saturdays a month)
